

HOUSE BLOCK

Requirements

Roof	10.1/2" x 3.1/2" fabric
Roof Corners	2 x 3.1/2" square
Windows	2 x 2" square) heat & bond
Door	5.1/2" x 2.1/2")
House Walls	Assorted strips of fabric Sew together fabric strips to about 11.1/2 wide by 8.1/2" tall. (cut finished piece to 10.1/2" wide by 7.1/2" tall)

Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of 3.1/2" squares and sew right sides together to each end of roof fabric. Press and cut off excess triangles. – press open

Sew roof to main body of house walls.

Place door in central position and windows each side.

House can be used as a block in a quilt, cushion centre etc.

COTTON REEL BLOCK

Requirements

Side strips	2 x 1.1/2" x 4.1/2" background fabric
Top & Bottom Squares	4 x 1.1/2" squares background fabric
Top & Bottom Strip	2 x 1.1/2" x 5.1/2" dark fabric
Centre thread section	Assorted strips of fabric

Build the centre of reel thread section by sewing assorted strips of fabric together, so you can cut out a rectangle size 3.1/2" wide and 4.1/2" tall

Sew a 1.1/2" x 4.1/2" background strip to each side.

Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the four 1.1/2" background squares.

Place a background 1.1/2" square on each end of 1.1/2" x 5.1/2" strip, right sides together, sew on diagonal lines. Press, trim seams and press open to make reel shape. Repeat with other strip.

Assemble by sewing top and bottom sections to main thread section

This completes one cotton reel block
